In the Theater field, the faculty's mission is to offer its graduates of the two specializations – Entertainment Arts (study directions: Acting, The Art of the Puppeteer Actor, Direction, Choreography) and Theatrology – Dramatic Journalism, study programs based on interdisciplinary research, meant to allow the reaching of professional abilities in dramatic creation.

By including all the three educational cycles – Bachelor's Degree, Master's Degree and PhD – the Faculty of Theater is involved in all its flagship projects in the community's life and it sets connections with the international environment by the created partnerships and by its research projects. Thinking about the past, we remember about the first show in Romanian (1816) and about the first music and declamation school (1836) that were founded by the exemplary contribution of Gheorghe Asachi.

We also think about important names like Matei Millo, Mihail Kogălniceanu, Vasile Alecsandri and many others, names that are connected forever to the history and destiny of Romanian theater, to all that is to be translated by development of national scenic art of the 19th and 20th centuries.

The prestige of the four show and concert professional institutions from Iaşi – the "Vasile Alecsandri" National Theater, the "Moldova" Philharmonic, the Romanian Opera and the "Luceafărul" Theater for Children and Youth – energized the interest for culture of a large category of public.

While today the superior art school has to prepare new generations of specialists to propagate the fame of a valuable tradition, by an alive and authentic impact, with the modernism of our times, with the issues and aspirations of the contemporary man.

Thus, in our case, our academic school prepares and trains professional actors, teachers in drama education, aesthetics and entertainment theory, practitioners and managers of scenic art, specialists the society really needs.

BACHELOR'S DEGREE STUDIES

PERFORMING ARTS – ACTING

Considered as to shape a professional and performance actor, the Curriculum of the Acting study program covers both the cultural side on which the structure of a true man of the stage stands for, and the practical one, specific to the profession, following this dual objective over the three years of study. Here is the beginning of a long but fabulous path. For all individual qualities such as sensitivity, clear diction, availability for empathy, imagination and the power to fantasize, agreeable outfit, and communication fluency are extensively simulated and educated in the spirit of the theatre and stage laws. Being there, on stage, requires an expressive, living presence; it requires intelligence and the sincerity of the entire conduct, a fine and clear diction, normal but full of nuances gestures, great persuasion power and, last but not least, personal charm, the ineffable mystery. Thus, from small parts, the young actor succeeds in achieving major parts. The studies can be fathomed during the Master's degree study cycle, which makes the transition towards the research area, a long-term investment and which opens new opportunities of entering the labor market.

PERFORMING ARTS - THE ART OF A PUPPETEER ACTOR

In the school theater, the puppeteer artist is trained, first of all, as a performance actor because the Acting-Puppets-Marionettes study program provides him with a double orientation, towards both the actor's art direction and the puppet and marionette handling art. Given the peculiarities of the profession he is heading for, the puppeteer-actor himself can become a spectacle or one-man-shows producer, being both manager and impresario. The optional courses range helps him add new pantomime, eurhythmics, biomechanics, or musical instrument study skills to his old ones. The option for a career in the field of animation theater art can provide high school graduates with the certainty of choosing an interesting and attractive profession, open to broad market requirements.

PERFORMING ARTS CHOREOGRAPHY

The Choreography study program aims at providing Choreography high school graduates or those who have completed only a segment of this training but who work in this artistic area with the opportunity to fathom their professional knowledge. Students may be dancers employed in opera, operetta, musical, ballet theatres and in ballet companies, who want to train for a career in the field of creation, prior to or after retirement – earlier among dancers than in other areas – or teachers of classical dance complementary specialties in vocational state or private secondary education (widespread throughout the country). Of the three major areas of vocational education – performing, creation, pedagogy – this program primarily regards the choreographic stage during the Bachelor's degree study program – but not being limited by it – following that, during the Master's degree studies, the emphasis is to turn to specialty pedagogy in secondary and higher education.

MASTER'S DEGREE STUDIES

PERFORMING ARTS - CONTEMPORARY THEATER

Over the years, the pedagogical activity practice has shown that most students discover the taste and interest in the complex research of the theatrical phenomenon, the taste and desire to thoroughly analyze the interlocking of the performing art components as synthesis art only in the last year of study, when more thorough preparations regarding the Bachelor's degree thesis begin. And this detail has made us think about the importance of the Master's degree classes, which have performing art as theme.

The Performing Arts – Contemporary Theatre university study program is a study line that comes to meet people involved in the theoretical and practical theatre process, graduates who already hold a university degree in the

field or in adjacent areas. Young theatre professionals have the opportunity of perfecting their interpretation techniques and of updating their information in order to successfully meet the requirements of an evolving cultural market.

The study program aims to provide practical, theoretical and conceptual information on new theatrical realities, providing the interested with the necessary tools for addressing different forms of dramatic performance.

The essential elements of the program are: raising awareness concerning the importance of the cultural project, beginning with the concept phase and ending with the public presentation of the final product; acquiring contemporary theatre interpretation techniques and methods, multidisciplinary; developing the creativity of the students following the Master's degree studies and encouraging independent projects designing by accessing national and international funding programs.

The mission of CTM – Iaşi, Contemporary Theater Master's Degree, is to train well-anchored in the current theater market professionals, professionals who come to meet the already formed public or who educate and engage with new audiences, so that art becomes an evolution spearhead of the contemporary society.

Around the central axis of this Master's Degree program – Theater project: concept, development, promotion, reception – different theater forms, such as the experimental, sports or social theater will be studied, but dramatic text writing rigors, light and sound design techniques, animation techniques in contemporary performance as well as cultural entrepreneurship forms will also be studied.

The fundamental objective of the program is ensuring the development of skills and abilities necessary to all professionals who want to integrate into the cultural market, either through individual performing formulas or affiliation to professional organizations in the field, the theatrical movement developing, thus, as a whole.

Through the theoretical and practical internship that follows the design of a personal theatre project, this type of postgraduate studies offers the possibility of a more rapid integration into the labor market.

The Artistic Management and Entrepreneurship Master's degree study program addresses people involved in various activity spheres within the cultural sector, graduates who already hold a university degree or young professionals in the cultural field from across the North-East of Romania, Republic of Moldova and North Bucovina. The purpose of the study program is to provide practical, theoretical and conceptual information on artistic management and entrepreneurship by providing the interested with theoretical and operational analysis tools, necessary for developing cultural-artistic affairs.

The essential elements of the program are: the balance between theoretical, conceptual and knowledge and the practical ones, acquiring cultural-artistic management methods and techniques, multidisciplinary and focus on developing the entrepreneurial spirit of the students following the Master's degree study program.

The mission of the MAME – Master in Artistic Management and Entrepreneurship – of laşi is, on the one hand, to train professionals in the cultural-artistic management, who come to meet creators and their works in order to support them during financing, production, dissemination and mediation stages and, on the other hand, to create optimal conditions for cultural manifestations and cultural good production (ideas and values), in order to translate them into available works for the public interested in culture, as well as for their reception by the public opinion.

The fundamental objective of the program is to ensure the development of necessary skills and abilities for all professionals who want to occupy top management positions in cultural-artistic organizations or for those wishing to develop entrepreneurial business in the artistic field.

Through the practice internships in various organizations and the task of creating a personal cultural-artistic project, this type of in-depth studies offers the possibility of acquiring practical experience in various artistic expressions.

PERFORMING ARTS - APPLICATIVE THEATRICAL STRUCTURES

Over the years, the pedagogical practice activity has demonstrated that most students show interest in the complex research of the theatrical phenomenon, the desire to thoroughly analyze the interlocking of the performing art components as synthesis art and the ways to exploit the space outside the stage and question the integration into the labor market only in the last year of study, when more thorough preparations regarding the Bachelor's degree thesis begin. The same concerns may be identified in students/graduates of related fields (pedagogy, philology, psychology, journalism), who are interested in the trans/interdisciplinary approach of theatrical techniques, in alternative forms.

These aspects have determined us to think about the importance of the MA studies – within the Faculty of Theatre - that should have APPLICATIVE THEATRICAL STRUCTURES as theme.

The MA program APPLICATIVE THEATRICAL STRUCTURES addresses people involved in various activity spheres of the cultural, education, and social field, graduates who already hold a university degree or young professionals in the field of culture and education throughout the North-East of Romania, Republic of Moldova and Northern

The purpose of the study program is to provide practical, theoretical and conceptual information on applicative theatrical techniques, providing the interested with theoretical and operational analysis tools, necessary for developing both cultural-artistic activities and communication skills.

The essential elements of the program are: the balance between the theoretical, conceptual, and practical knowledge, acquiring applicative theatrical structure techniques, multidisciplinary, and emphasizing development of the skills required to structure an educational project of theatrical or cultural and artistic nature organized.

The mission of the MSTA – Iaşi, MA in Applicative Theatrical Structure – is to train professionals in the education and cultural-artistic field, who meet the needs of the contemporary society - on the one hand, from the mentioned fields, and, on the other hand, to create optimal conditions for the training of the higher education graduates (and of the Psycho-pedagogical Training Module level I, prerequisite for completing level II) in order to be able to take part in specific activities: organizing and coordinating activities within the "Theatre Circles", teaching optional disciplines (included in the school based curriculum) from the theatrical education sphere, theatrical activities within the Cultural Centers.

The fundamental objective of the program is to ensure the development of skills and competencies required of all professionals who wish to unfold theatrical and communication activities at the highest quality standards in cultural, artistic or educational organizations. Through the internships - in various organizations - and the task of creating a personal applicative theatrical project, this type of postgraduate program provides the possibility of gaining practical experience.

According to the List of Occupations in Romania, MSTA - Iaşi graduates will be able to occupy primary school teacher, art teacher, other art form instructor, and cultural specialist positions.
