ABSTRACT OF THE HABILITATION THESIS

The habilitation thesis entitled *The Stylistic Fusion in Music Production, from Classical Genres to Jazz/Pop/Rock*, **follows** the path of **my** personal professional development, **describing** the **foremost** achievements in **several** fields of music creation: composition and arranging, sound engineering, scientific research, publishing, teaching, music performing and music production/management.

These activities bring together all stages of the music production, from the musical idea to the audio album, concert or show, based on the research needed in developing new projects and directions. All of these have contributed to the enhancement of my skills and competencies, in guiding and leading a scientific research in the complexities of the musical field, with a focus on the stylistic area of the jazz/ pop/rock genres.

Chapter 1, entitled Professional Path prior to the Doctorate, focuses on details about my training, my teaching activity between 1999 and 2013 in the non-regulated, secondary musical education, as an associate professor and then assistant professor in the specialization of *Jazz Composition and Pop Music*, culminating with my most important achievement - the implementation of two courses: *Computer-assisted Sound Processing* and *Sound Engineering*, as well as my work as a sound engineer/music director within the Romanian Broadcasting Society - Radio Iași Studio.

Chapter 2 focuses on my personal activity, with the doctoral studies as a starting point, in the fields of teaching, musical composition and arranging, music performance, sound engineering, research and publication of studies and books, musical production - each one being presented in a dedicated subchapter. As in most cases I had a substantial activity in these fields before and concurrent with the university career, each subchapter also includes my achievements before the doctoral studies.

Subchapter 2.1 details my research and work within the doctoral studies in composition with the theme "The Modern *Musical*. Research and Original Composition", followed by the teaching activity, starting with the year of 2013, consisting in the complete reorganization of the *Music Arrangement* and *Music Ensemble* courses (notably, splitting the initial course into *Jazz* and *Pop Ensemble*

respectively, each one with **a** dedicated curriculum) within the specialization *Jazz Composition and Pop Music*, establishing and designing new courses: *Jazz Ensemble* for classical saxophone, brass and percussion **students**, *Music Technology*, **as well as** the establishment of new ensembles **such as**: *FICS Jazz & Pop Orchestra* and *UNAGE Big Band* - the jazz orchestra of the "*George Enescu" University of Arts* in Iași.

Subchapter 2.2 presents my activity as a music performer - bass guitar player - in various bands, ensembles and projects - and as a conductor of *OPIS Big Band* and *UNAGE Big Band*. Subchapter 2.3 presents my activity as a sound engineer both within the Romanian Broadcasting Society and as an independent engineer, my most notable achievements being the recording of albums with renowned jazz musicians such as Nicolas Simion and Sorin Romanescu.

Subchapter 2.4, entitled Activity as a Composer and Arranger is the most extensive one, because this is my main activity in the field of music. The most important works and achievements are presented, starting with 2001: those that materialized in the form of stage productions, such as musicals Cabotinul, Interesul *poartă fesul*, as well as the most extensive and complex work of this kind - the rock opera The One Born from a Tear, which was staged across the country, was broadcast on radio and television and was also awarded The Union of Romanian Composers and Musicologists Prize in 2015. Other works are albums such as My World and the Famous Tangos 2, released by Roton record label, arrangements/songs commissioned by important bands or groups: such projects as those produced in partnership with the alternative rock band - Byron - Byron Electric Marching Band, consisting in arrangements for wind orchestra, rock band and choir, performed on the stage of the Cluj National Theatre, broadcast on HBO and released as a DVD by Universal *Records*; also, the Byron 100 ALTOrchestra project, or pieces/arrangements commissioned by the a cappella vocal group *Blue Noise* and/or acquired by UCMR. In their analysis, I aimed in particular to highlight various ways of approaching the stylistic fusion between the classical genres and those of the jazz/pop/rock family, which is a stylistic feature of my own creation and also an element of originality.

Subchapter 2.5 details my activity as a music producer, starting with 2001, in producing music albums as well as in the production of concerts and shows, the most notable achievements being the concerts and video clips of the *FICS Jazz & Pop Orchestra*, the *UNAGE Big Band* concerts in Târgu Mureş, culminating with the stage

productions of *The One Born from a Tear* rock opera. The latter are **analysed** in detail due to their national uniqueness and their **vast** complexity, **with a focus on those performed by** singers, **a** rock band and **a** mixed choir, **accompanied by a** full symphony orchestra, (performed in Iaşi, Bacău, Ploiești and Brașov), as well as those with **a** hybrid orchestra, consisting of 9 singers, **a** rock band and **a** virtual orchestra, probably a national premiere in the opera show productions, (performed in Piatra Neamț and Iași), where, during the *Independent Opera Festival*, organized by *The Iași Athenaeum*, **it** was awarded *The Prize for Originality* in 2017.

Subchapter 2.6 addresses my research and scientific activity in the field of musicology and sound engineering as well as my activity as a writer, describing studies and books published in the field of musicology - *A Stylistic Approach to the History of the Musical Genre*, Artes Publishing House, Iasi, 2016 - a premiere in our country, which researches and analyzes in depth the genre of the musical (awarded the Bronze Medal at the International *Salon of Euroinvent*), the books *The One Born from a Tear, a Modern Musical in the 2010s Romania*, Artes Publishing House, Iaşi, 2018, which analyses in detail the work with the same name, *The One Born from a Tear - the general orchestra score*, Artes Publishing House, Iaşi, 2018 (awarded the Gold Medal at the *Euroinvent Salon*), as well as the book *Music Technology - Sound Reinforcement Equipment and Techniques*, Eikon Publishing House, Bucharest 2017, the first book in Romania on the subject of modern equipment, including the digital one, and processes in the field of sound engineering used in sound reinforcement, in an accessible to the general public approach, a book that covers a gap of about 40 years in Romania (the latest books in the field having been written in the '70s).

Chapter 3 - illustrates **the perspective of my career in the future**, **following** the same 4 directions: teaching, research/writing, music composition/arranging and music production, with a focus on some stylistic directions **that have already** proved successful, and **adding up** new works, **developing further** publishing projects (i.e., the extension of the *Music Technology* **book into** a series of publications covering all areas of application of this technology), **or designing** new courses in a modern, digital format.
